They help us better connect with our investors on a one-on-one basis. Eight two ribbon cuttings were held last year. Cindy talked about our signature events and reviewed the mission of the council.

Cindy wants to add smaller events throughout the year that surround women, along with our major signature event in the fall. Cindy asked for input for good programming for us throughout the year. The council suggested two to three smaller events and then the main signature event in October. Debbie Conner offered a workshop that she's done at other conferences, "Leading from the Middle". Karen sent Cindy a webinar that is named "Effective Presentation Skills, Communicate with Confidence". Cindy wanted to determine what classes we would hold and then find facilitators for them. Cecilia Evans shared with Cindy that we could do a class on financial health across generations. Cindy asked if Eileen had any questions that had been asked to her. Eileen said she's had three clients ask how to communicate better with people that work remotely. Anna

Strickland mentioned Jeff Black has a class that is called "Black Sheep" and it discusses communication and training. He does the power ball drawing for the South Carolina Lottery. Alex asked how big the smaller events would be. Cindy said the classes would have fifty to seventy-five max attendees and it will vary. We could do a breakfast or lunch. Pine Lakes does a great breakfast, could be an option for a venue as well as the Dunes Club. Mary suggested a popular topic is women negotiating, we could possibly have someone teach on this from one of the universities. Eileen agreed that Debbie's class would be very beneficial and educational. Strengths Finders is a class to determine strengths within each individual and how it can assist as a whole group with working together. Melissa Bilka suggested this course. Brittany Donettelli is certified in this course and works at Coastal University.

Shannon said her first reaction is to not over saturate and add additional events. That way we can single into the event, encourage people to come and have a networking component. Melissa suggested having a power breakfast, you have a speaker that is a woman in a leadership role, and they could tell their story of how they got to that position. In between the classes you can encourage networking and set time apart for that. The BMW conference had a great layout, and she was one of the facilitators for one of the sessions. She was extremely powerful and had a great story! At the beginning of the conference, we want

each facilitator to market themselves to the attendees and discuss the importance of why the attendees should come to their session. This will help the attendees gain excitement for what they are about to learn and help them better decide. Another suggestion was for Nicole Malakowski, who was the first Thunderbird pilot and has a powerful story.
