The second workshop is locked in as well for a lunch with Dr. Debbie Conner that is called Leading From the Middle.

<u>Discussion Items</u> All

Conference tagline – Cindy asked if we wanted a tagline that encapsulates what the conference is about this year. Mary mentioned that the tagline would be action oriented, it ties along with what women are thinking about during that time. Help keeps relevance and promotes the conference. We could do the tagline as we add speakers. Unite (bringing people together), Ignite (momentum), Inspire (influence them to take action).

Speakers – Cindy would like Precious Williams to be the keynote speaker. She mentioned how great she is and a bit of her story and how engaging she was. It will make a huge difference on the number of exhibitors we have. The booth space will remain at \$350, which includes their space, table and two chairs.

Bookstore: Cindy asked Mary to discuss her thoughts on having a bookstore at the event. Mary thinks we should have a bookstore order a certain amount of books and speakers will do book signings as well. The books that are sold at the conference will have meaningful titles. Another idea is to have merchandise at the bookstore. This year we will have a plated lunch, with one meat and two sides. It will include chicken, starch, vegetable and salad. Mary asked about the breakfast and said it was bare last year. She suggested having yogurt, protein bars, fruit and muffins. Kema will look into different options that we can have. The afternoon break will have protein bars.
